## **New Family Welcome Kits**

Welcome Kits will be given to new families moving into our motel program. These kits will provide the family with basic necessities, and help the family feel at home in their new living situation!

Kits should be put in a large storage container, and include:

Weekly Planner	Pots and Pans
Can Opener	Laundry Detergent
Paper plates and bowls	Utensils
Cups	Disposable Plastic Containers
Ziploc Bags	Dish soap
Flashlight (with batteries)	Disinfectant Wipes
Bottled Water	

## **Children's Activity Bags**

Children's Activity Bags will be handed out to children who come into our office while they are waiting for their parent to meet with their social worker, or receive other needed assistance.

Activity Bags are made for children of all ages, though during the school year, we tend to have the youngest children come in with parents as they are not in school.

The contents can vary depending on what you would like to provide! Some ideas include coloring books, crayons, crossword puzzles, etc.

## **Snack Bags**

Snack Bags will be handed out to both children and adults who come into our office for assistance.

Bags can vary, but should include all non-perishable, and non-refrigerated items. Some ideas include granola bars, juice, crackers, fruit snacks, etc.

## **Adopt a Month**

To ensure that we have a constant supply of food and goods in our pantry, FACETS has a monthly donations calendar. Groups can "adopt a month," promising to provide supplies in the following areas:

- Non-perishable foods (pop-top soups, crackers, peanut butter and jelly, bottled water, etc.)
- Hygiene items & Household supplies (soap, shampoo and conditioner, toothbrushes and toothpaste, laundry detergent, all purpose cleaner, paper towels, etc.)
- Welcome Kits
- Snack and Activity Bags

There is no minimum donation requirement, all we ask is that you help provide us with these items so that we can provide them to our clients!
