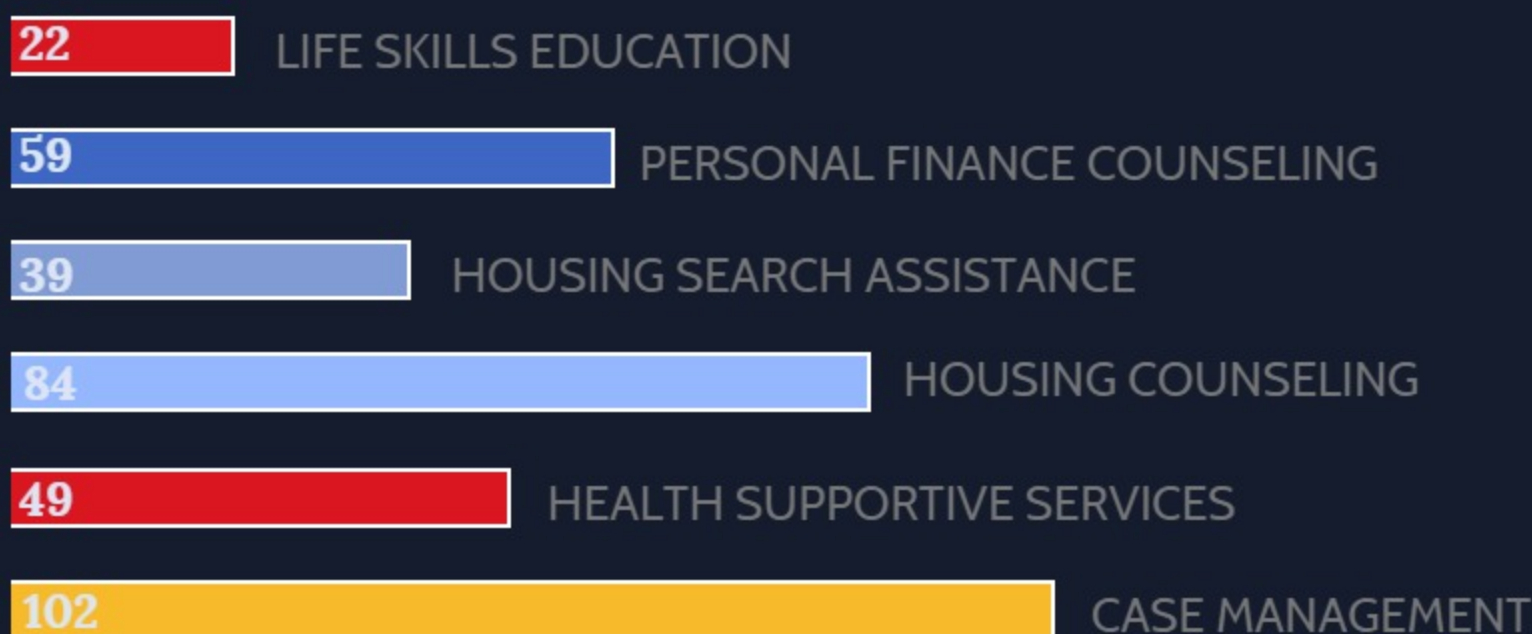

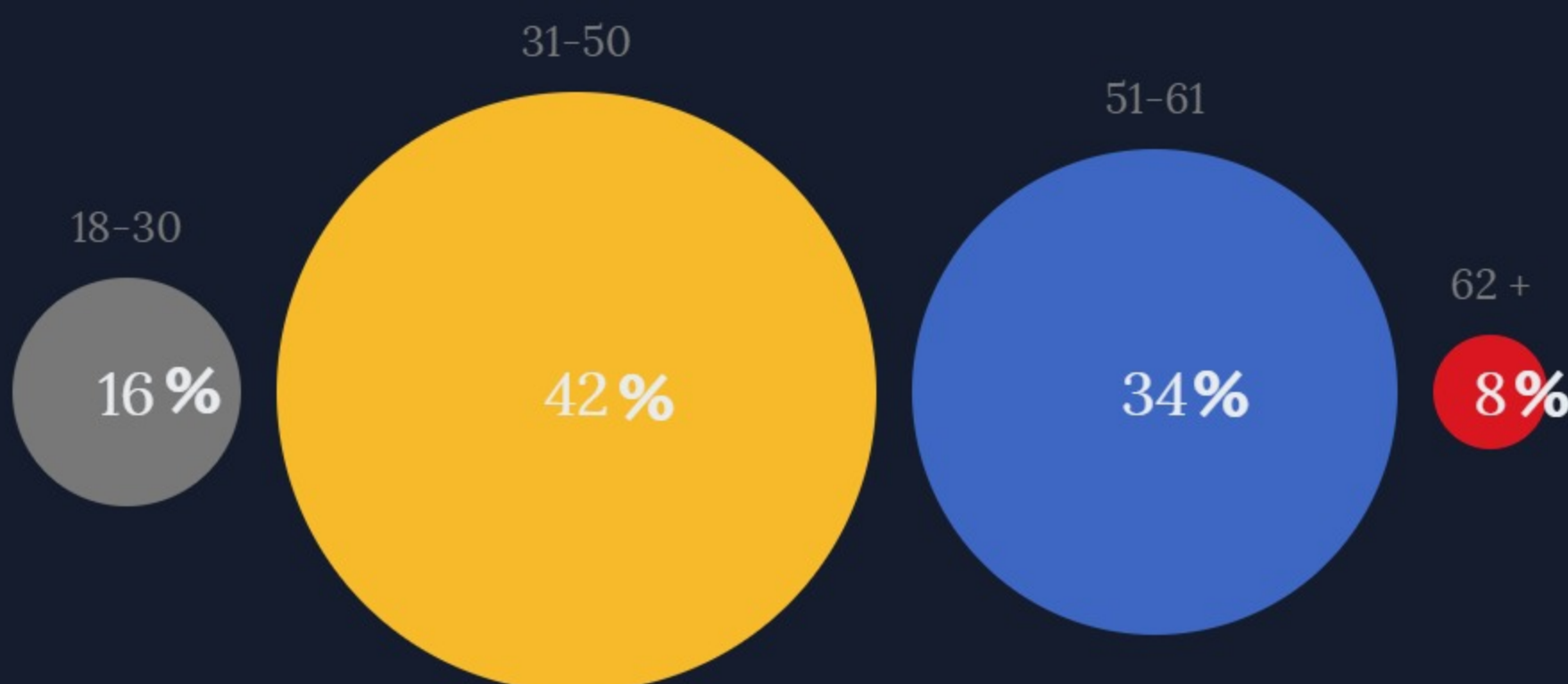
## GENDER/AGE BREAKDOWN
