Position Title	Adult Computer Time - Lead Volunteer
Purpose	Oversee computer lab during designated times open to all adult residents.
Key Responsibilities	 Support the mission of FACETS. Open and close lab, track resident participation, and ensure appropriate use of computers (e.g., ensure content is suitable for community environment). Support residents using the lab to develop basic computer literacy skills, conducting job searches, creating resumes, furthering education, and managing other life responsibilities. Provide technical support as needed. Ensure priority is given to residents using the lab for non-leisure purposes. Occasionally be responsible for opening/closing the Community Center and supervising other volunteers in the absence of the Community Advocate. Other related duties as assigned.
Time Commitment Supervisor	1 hour per week for duration of a semester. Community Advocate for selected property
Qualifications	 Possess proficient computer skills. Effective communication skills to maintain a well-organized lab environment. Passion for working with adults and desire to provide encouragement of positive life skills. Understanding of current social services, homeless, housing issues, and methods/approaches for addressing issues. Flexibility and ability to change priorities as necessary. Positive and professional attitude and demeanor. Self-reliant problem solver and team player.
