Position Title	Boys or Girls Group (Jr./Sr.) - Lead Volunteer
Purpose	The position will direct the support volunteers to maximize their effectiveness in helping children complete assigned homework and engage in various activities geared toward boys or girls.
Key Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Willing to support the mission of FACETS. • Commit to 1 hour per week for the entire school year. • Create and implement behavioral learning contracts as needed. • Plan prevention and recreational activities. • Communicate with the Boys/Girls Group Support Volunteer on lesson plans a day or two before group meets. • Use positive behavior management in dealing with boys or girls. • Lead and facilitate groups for young men or young women. • Supervise 10-15 youth in attendance. • Occasionally be responsible to open/close the Community Center and supervise other volunteers in the absence of the Community Advocate. • Other related duties as assigned.
