Purpose	Oversee computer lab during designated times open to all adult residents.
Key Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the mission of FACETS. • Open and close lab, track resident participation, and ensure appropriate use of computers (e.g., ensure content is suitable for community environment). • Support residents using the lab to develop basic computer literacy skills, assisting on school projects, furthering education, and managing other life responsibilities. • Provide technical support as needed. • Provide help on school projects. • Ensure priority is given to residents using the lab for non-leisure purposes. • Occasionally be responsible for opening/closing the Community Center and supervising other volunteers in the absence of the Community Advocate. • Other related duties as assigned.
