(If you are unable to make a class please call the lead volunteer and/or Program Coordinator) Log participation of clients Sign in, and record number of hours volunteered. Communicate with the FACETS Community Development Advocate about any special need, problem or concern that you observe amongst participants. Enforce FACETS rules fairly and consistently.
Time	Volunteers are asked to make a minimum commitment of one semester (fall, spring, or
Commitment	summer), but a year-long commitment is encouraged. 1 hour per week, plus preparation.

Qualifications	 Basic ESL instruction experience. Effective basic communication skills. Ability to empathize with another person. Flexibility and openness to differing points of view. Dependability and consistency in meeting two hours per week for a minimum of one year.
