Position Title	Summer Program Intern, Education & Community Development Program (ECD)
Purpose	Provide oversight and support for youth summer program
Key Responsibilities/Program Description	 Work alongside Community Development Advocate to provide support for summer program In the event that the Community Development Advocate must be absent, the Summer Program Intern will serve as the point person for program activities Assist with planning and coordination of all program components Assist with managing volunteers and youth participants Communicate with Community Development Advocate as needed, regarding behavior issues, absences, supplies needed, etc. Program will run from 12pm-5pm each day 12-1pm = Lunch 1-5pm = Planned Programs At least one day per week we will be taking the kids on field trips Intern will need to plan and lead programs to fill the 1-5pm "Planned Programs" time Programs can be tailored to fit the talents/interests of the intern Intern can ideally arrive 30 minutes before programs start (at 11:30am-12pm) in order to spend time planning/preparing for the day and stay 30 minutes after the program (5-5:30pm) to help clean up and use the extra time to plan/prepare for the next day
